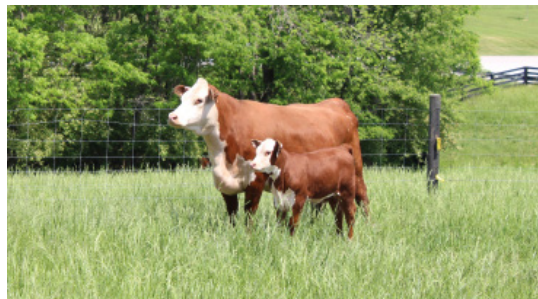

Objectives

- Demonstrate the improvement and quality of Hereford cattle in Kentucky and surrounding states.
- A consistent outlet for breeders of quality Hereford cattle where their cattle can be grouped in numbers sufficient to garner prices that reward them for producing quality cattle.
- Increased consistency and predictability for the buyers of our cattle.
- A higher quality product for our consumers.

Health Requirements

- Vaccinated and boosted for IBR, BVD, BRSV, PI3 Pasteurella & Blackleg (the viral booster must be modified live).
- Dewormed within the time window.
- Polled or dehorned and healed.
- Wean and bunk broke for at least 45 days.

Sale Management

- Consignor fees will be \$2.00 for the CHB ear tag and \$4.00 consignment fee to the KHA to cover advertising and promotion.
- Stockyard commission will be \$20.00 per head.
- Cattle will be sorted into 100 pound increment pens by three breed sorts; Hereford, Red Cross & Black Cross.
- Sale management will review the sorted and graded cattle and may combine some pens to make load lots.
- All cattle will be graded by KY Dept. of Ag Graders and off or #2 cattle will be penned separately.
- Cattle **MUST ARRIVE** by 2:00 PM on May 12, 2021 to be included in the Graded Hereford Sale. If cattle arrive on sale day those cattle will be sold in the regular sale only.



Important Dates

- Ownership deadline: March 14
- Tag order deadline: April 13
(call Association Representative)
- Weaning deadline: March 29
- Vaccination window: February 12 - April 29
- Deworming window:
No earlier than March 14
(if Long Range is used after February 2)
- Delivery time: May 12 by 2:00 PM

Consignors Must

- Be able to verify at least 50% Hereford influence.
- Tag their animals with a Kentucky Certified Hereford tag.
- Deliver healthy, sound, marketable cattle.
- Have polled or dehorned and healed cattle.
- Wean and bunk broke for at least 45 days.
- Vaccinate according to the standard protocol.
- Deworm all cattle.
- Castrate bulls (knife is recommended) must be HEALED.
- Guarantee heifers to be open.

III. Recommended Nutrition

- Provide high quality, high energy rations first 3-5 days post-weaning
- Trained to eat feed from a bunk and drink water from a trough. (Do not overfeed! Fleshy calves should be avoided and are likely to be discounted.)
- Free choice salt and mineral supplement which contains a minimum of 1,000 ppm copper (no copperoxide), 26 ppm selenium, 2,000 ppm zinc & 1,000 ppm manganese.

IV. Other Requirements

Health Records

- Must complete, sign and send to Blue Grass Stockyards the sale certification form regarding name of vaccine, lot or serial number, dates and location of administration, and also the
- Producer needs to attach the purchase receipts of the vaccines.

Processing

- All bull calves are recommended to be knife cut and healed prior to or at weaning. Late castrated calves may lead to stags, which are discounted.
- HORNS: All cattle will be dehorned, smooth headed and healed or polled. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- Administration of vaccine
 1. Use the neck area for intramuscular injections
 2. Use subcutaneous injection if labeled on product which also should be given in the neck area
 3. Follow label directions and handle vaccines properly

Electronic Ear Tags

- CHB EID ear tags are required on all cattle and may be ordered from the Kentucky Beef Network

V. ALL SALES ARE ABSOLUTE!

Heifers are guaranteed open at time of sale and steers are guaranteed not to be bulls/stags. Seller agrees to reimburse buyer \$200.00 for pregnant heifers or bulls/stags. All claims must be properly verified by a veterinarian within five (5) months of sale.
