
Instructions for Enrolling the KY BQCA Course in the Online Learning Environment


- 1. To access the KY BQCA course, go to
- 2. Click on the "Access Online KY BQCA Course" button as shown below.




3. Click the "Courses" button




4. Go to the search bar and search "KY BQCA"

6. Click "Checkout"




7. If you are a new user, click the "CREATE NEW ACCOUNT" button.




11. The BQCA course will appear on the screen under "Course Overview." Click "Kentucky Beef Quality Care Assurance Program" as seen below to begin training. If you need to access the BQCA training later, it will be located under the "My Courses" tab at the top of your screen on campus.extension.org.






12. Every enrollee must complete Module A – BQCA Overview. Then you must complete 2 of the remaining modules (Any Modules B-F).




13. Click on the Module A Overview and watch the video, then on the bottom right, click "BQCA Overview-Module A Assessment" and click "Attempt Quiz Now". Once you have answered the questions for Module A, click the "Finish Attempt" button in the bottom right-hand corner. You will be redirected to a "Summary of attempt" page, where you can look over your answers. If you would like to change an answer for this module, click "Return to attempt". If you are satisfied with these answers, click "Submit all and finish" at the bottom of the page.





- 14. Once your answers for Module A are submitted, you can review your answers and view your results (a passing grade is 85% or higher on each assessment taken). Click "finish review" on bottom right to return to summary page. To retake the test, click "Re-attempt quiz". You have multiple attempts for each module test.
- 15. Once you have passed your quiz make sure to click the "Notification of Completion" button then go on to hit the "Get Certificate" button after every module to fully complete the module. Failure to do so will make you unable to achieve overall completion of the module.



You must generate a "Notification of Completion" in order to receive credit for this Module. The Learning Management System controls the wording on the button below that reads "Get Certificate". Please note that this is NOT your BQCA certificate. The BQCA certificate will be issued by the Kentucky Beef Network after you have successfully completed the requirements for certification. Simply click on the "Get Certificate" button to generate a pdf file of your "Notification of Completion". A separate window will open. You can simply close that window to proceed to other Modules.

You need to complete two additional modules to get your BQCA Certification.


